

Sand Tray Group Play Therapy in Schools and Clinics from an Interpersonal Neurobiology (IPNB) Perspective

Accredited Play Therapy Training (Total 18 accredited hours)

Weaving together the science-informed concepts of interpersonal neurobiology (IPNB) and group dynamics, we will explore the healing power of relational play within the context of sand and miniatures. To accomplish this, we will review what neuroscientists are saying about the brain's need to make sense of life experiences through storytelling in ways that help people bond with one another. We will talk about brains and relationships as examples of complex systems that reach their best potential when differentiated parts of the system (whether they be neural networks or individuals in the group) link together to form a more coherent system. Translating this abstract concept to what actually unfolds in sand tray groups of all ages will be our unifying task over the three days of this seminar. Staying with an interpersonal focus, we will talk about mirror neurons and mindfulness as we explore the meaning of "holding space for group experience," along with the challenges that facilitators often experience when they attempt to stay fully present.
